

Immunization Reporting Made Easier for Licensed Child Care Providers

Vermont Immunization Registry

The Vermont Immunization Registry (IMR) is a secure health information system that has immunization records for persons living in Vermont. Licensed and Registered child care providers may use the IMR to find immunization records for the children in their care – with a parent or guardian's permission.

The IMR has a special "red light/green light" report called the Licensed Child Care Report that shows you at a glance if the child meets the immunization requirements. That means you do not need to count vaccine doses or figure out abbreviations on medical records. Using the IMR assures that your assessment and reporting is accurate.

Important: the IMR is not the place where you complete your annual immunization coverage report. It is a tool that you may use to help complete the report.

How do I get access to the IMR?

To apply for a username and password, complete an access agreement form and submit it via email to MR@vermont.gov or fax (802) 652-4157, or mail to 108 Cherry St, PO Box 70, Burlington, VT 05402.




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Example of an immunization record, and the easy-to-read Child Care Report:

This special report is an easy to read record that shows whether the child in your care meets the requirements for immunization.



The Child Care Report will look like this:
