MONKEYPOX

On May 26, 2022, the Vermont Health Department issued a Health Advisory on the monkeypox virus with recommendations for Vermont health care providers.

At that time there were no known cases in Vermont, and that is still true – there are no known cases in Vermont as of July 13. However, there are cases in each of the surrounding states and in Quebec so it is important to be prepared to encounter patients who are or may be infected with the monkeypox virus.
