2. Call to Order; Introduce New Members; Call the Roll; Acknowledge Guests:

Mr. Hoser welcomed Commissioner Harry Chen, MD.

Dr. Chen expressed thanks to the Board members for their work then provided an update on some current Health Department matters relevant to the Board's work. He explained that as a former Board member, he has special appreciation for the dedication and work of the Board. He also thanked Mr. Herlihy, the office staff and the AAGs for their contributions.

Dr. Chen noted that he sees the role of the Board as protecting and promoting healthy Vermonters, which aligns with the mission of the Department of Health. He also noted that the Medical Board sets the tone of decisions and policies of other medical professions and boards in the state, and urged members to contact him if ever they feel he could impact an issue of importance to the Board.

Dr. Chen went on to discuss and answer questions about legislative issues including the Interstate Compact, the Vermont Prescription Monitoring System, vaccinations, and the new policies and rules regarding in the areas of treatment of substance abuse and child protection laws, such as the changes to Mandatory Reporting.

Dr. Chen will continue to keep the Board updated either via Mr. Herlihy or in person

and thanked the members for their time.

6. Administrative Update (Mr. Herlihy):

Mr. Herlihy introduced and welcomed George Belcher who is the successful bidder for the Presiding Officer contract. He advised that the contract is in process and that it is hoped Mr. Belcher will begin in the near future. Members were advised that the current Presiding Officer, Mr. Simpson, has agreed to extend his contract to cover the time while Mr. Belcher's contract is processed, and also to be available for some cases that have begun but that have not yet been completed.

Mr. Herlihy provided a brief update on the status of the Stephanie Taylor, MD hearing and noted that it would possibly come before the Board at a future meeting, likely October or November.

Mr. Herlihy noted that Ms. Coyner quickly coming to speed filling the second Board Investigator position. Although travel difficulties prevented her from attending Certified Medical Board Investigator training in August, she has been able to register for CLEAR training in Boston during September.

Mr. Herlihy also noted that the upgrade for CAVU is still being tested, and in the meantime another IT system is being considered.

Mr. Herlihy stated that he, Ms. McClain, Ms. Deiderich, and Dr. Hayward participated in a panel as part of a course at the University of Vermont College of Medicine on regulation and oversight of the medical profession. The course was created by former Chair, Dr. King. The course continues to be well received and he would like for the Board to continue to support it through participation.

Mr. Herlihy noted that on September 14 he will again be participating in the grand rounds with VMPS and the Department of Public Safety to discuss best practices in opioid prescribing and treating opioid addiction. This edition will be at UVMMC and

there will be more to follow over the fall and winter.

Mr. Herlihy gave a brief update on the newsletter that he hopes will go out this month. He noted that Dr. Reich, Ms. Sproul, Dr. Hayward, Dr. Clattenburg and Mr. LeCours had all graciously agreed to review the articles.
