

Using the IMR to Complete VFC Re-Enrollment Form

- IF you have been entering "current" immunizations for your patients, and
- IF you are up to date with entering records,


You can use the IMR to determine the # of children in your practice who are **Medicaid eligible** and the # of children who have **no insurance**. Here's how:

→ Go to any patient record, and click on the Immunization Registry tab at the upper left corner of the screen.

→ Choose **Patient Count by Practice Report**

→ Choose All Patients (under 18) and create report.

The report shows # Medicaid patients by age. To calculate the number with no insurance, just subtract the # of Medicaid patients from the # VFC Eligible. In the example below, the practice has 108 children in the age group 1-6 years. Of these, 21 were Medicaid enrolled. Another 8 (29 VFC eligible minus 21 Medicaid enrolled) had no insurance.
