Mr. Herlihy stated that he has been fielding questions from physicians about the Continuing Medical Education requirements for the next licensing cycle, and the next challenge will be creating the tracking system within CAVU. He informed them that regarding the CAVU system generally, there have been several glitches in the first few weeks of the renewal period and processing is slightly behind where it needs to be. Mr. Herlihy anticipates the issues will get resolved and Tracy will get caught up very quickly.

Mr. Herlihy reminded the members about the CME course on Opioid Training 10/20/2012 at the Equinox Hotel in Manchester, VT. Any members interested in attending may do so.

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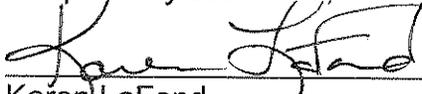
