

## SUMMARY STATISTICS

**Occurrence** statistics include all events recorded in Vermont, including those involving visitors living outside Vermont. **Resident** statistics are limited to the events involving people with legal residence in Vermont, including events occurring outside Vermont. In 2004, reports of births and deaths to Vermonters were received from 25 states and Canada.
