HOW TO RECORD A 12-LEAD IN SIREN ELITE

In the old SIREN, you could record a 12-Lead in the procedures list, or in the "Add EKG" section within the Vitals/Treatment tab. In the new SIREN Elite, the 12-Leads have been taken out of the procedure list, so you will record all your 12-leads in the ECG grids on the Treatment Panel, located within the Provider Action section.
