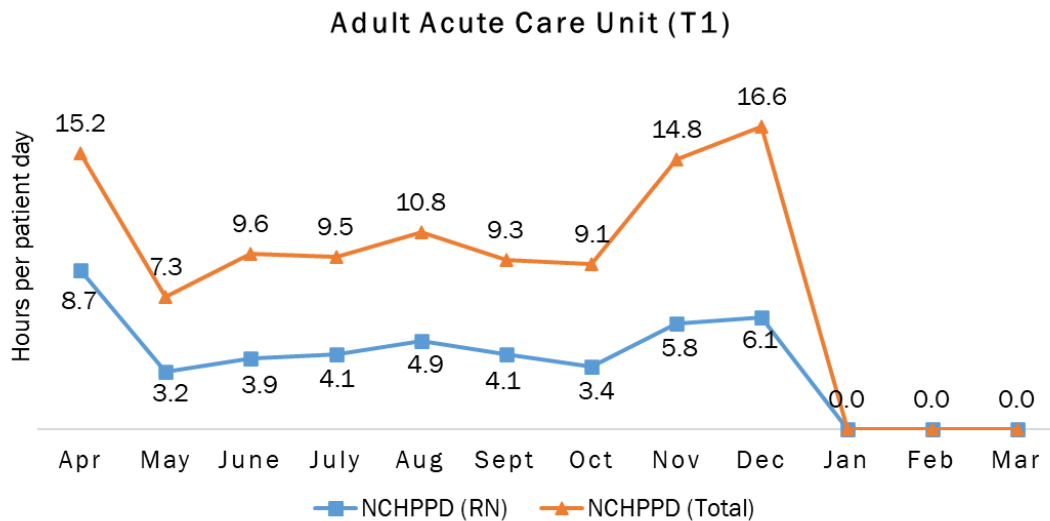

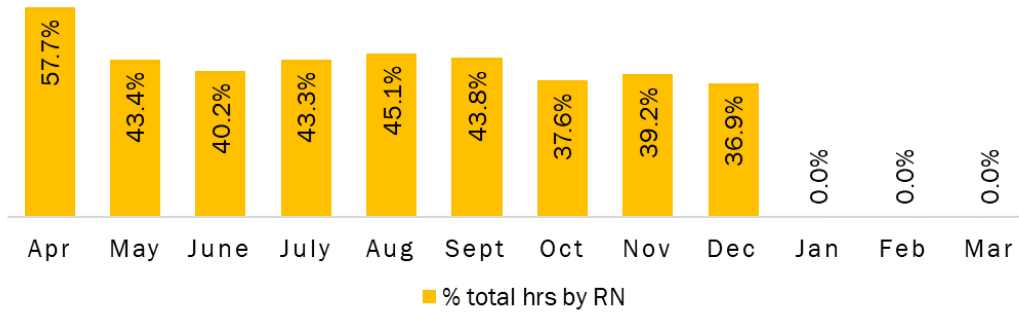

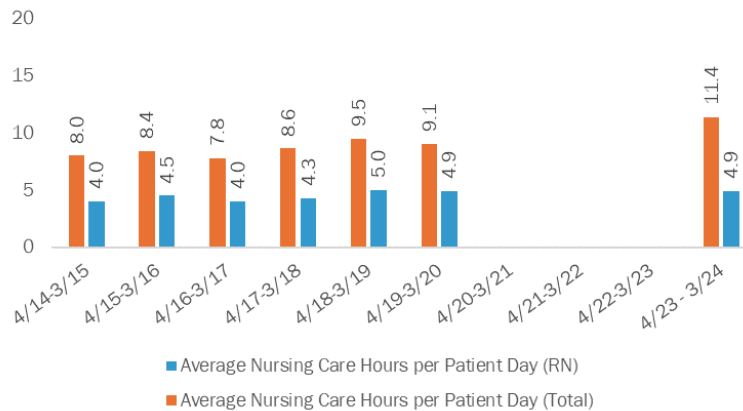

Adult Acute Care Unit (T1) 2014 - 2024

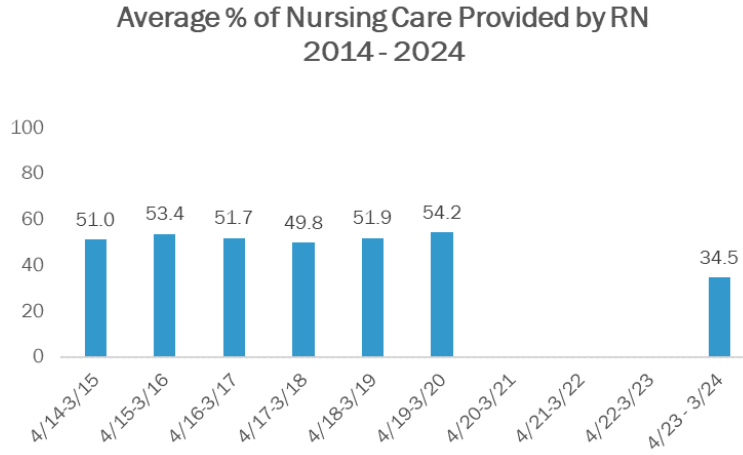

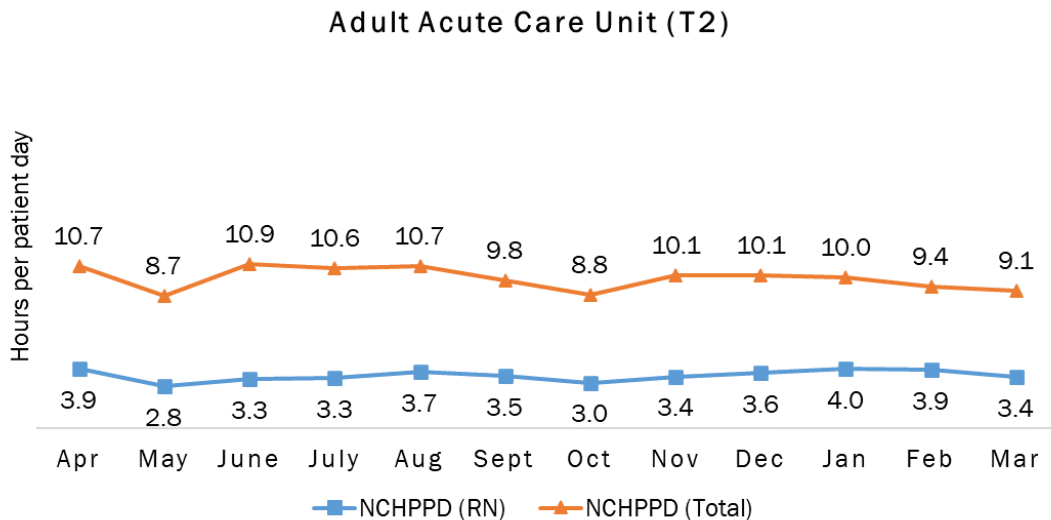

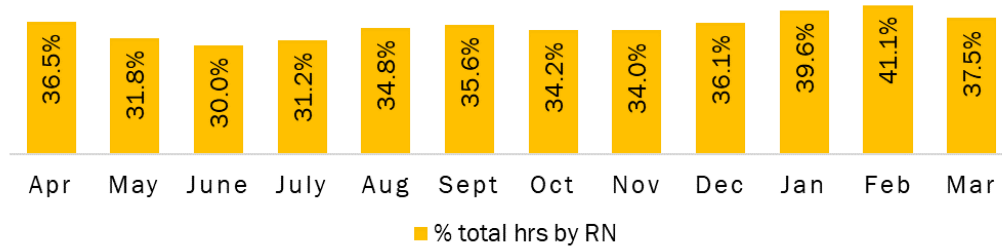

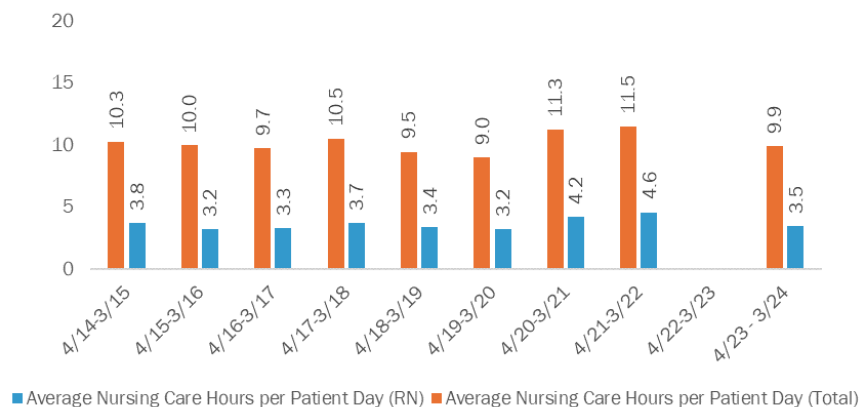

Adult Acute Care Unit (T2) 2014 - 2024

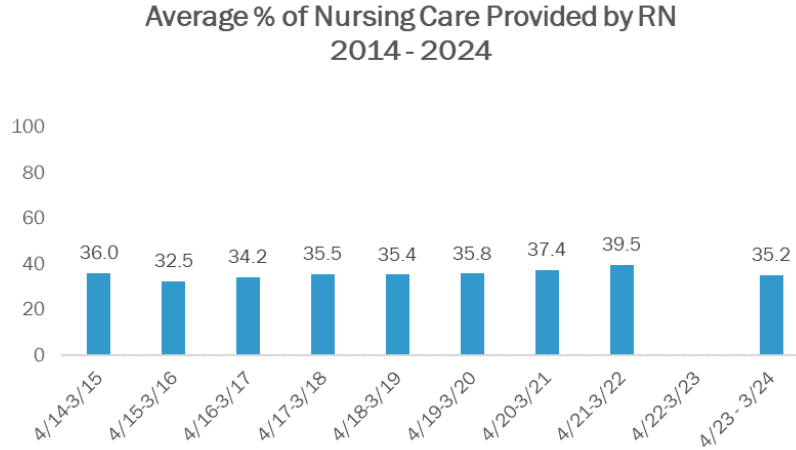

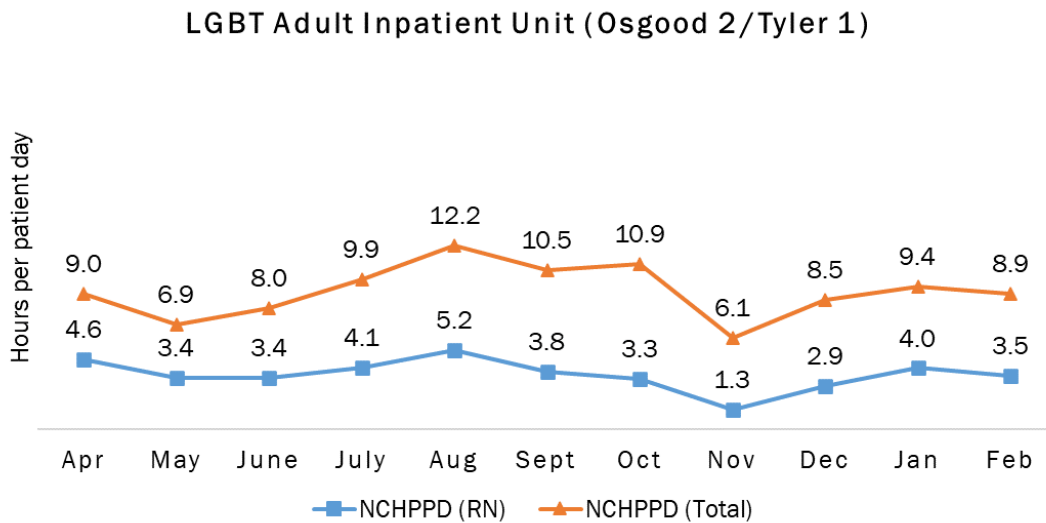

The Adult Inpatient Unit opened in 2009. The program moved from Osgood 2 to Tyler 1, increasing the licensed bed capacity from 15 to 21. This program includes a track for the treatment of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender adults. Services provided in this setting include secure, inpatient care for individuals with a mental health diagnosis. Some individuals in this unit may need constant 1-to-1 nursing care.

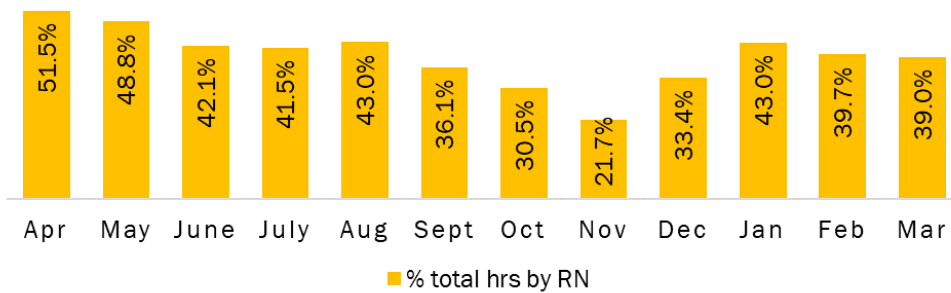

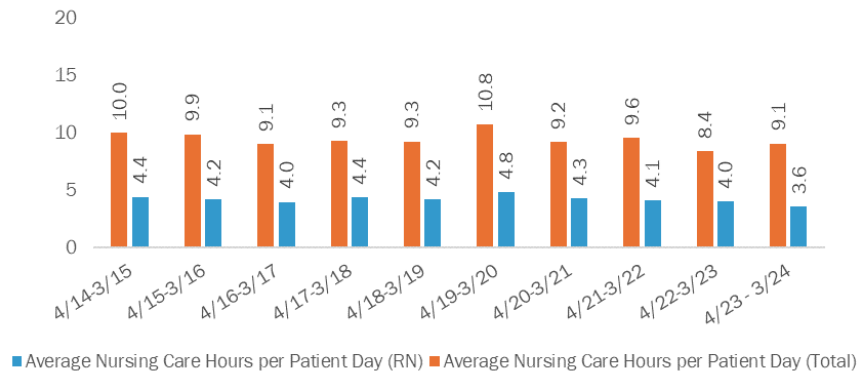

Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2014 - 2024

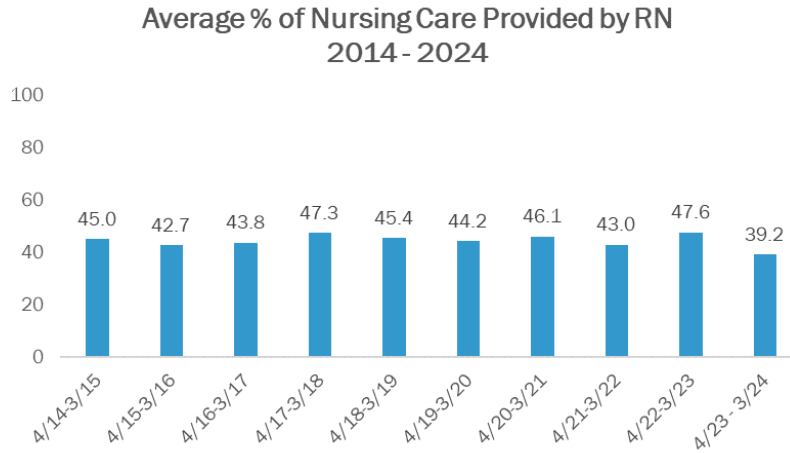

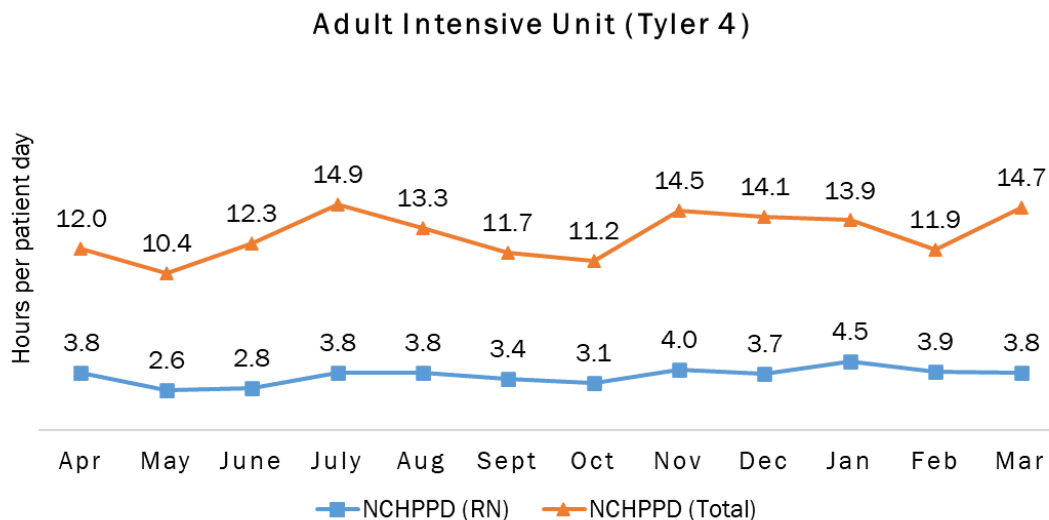

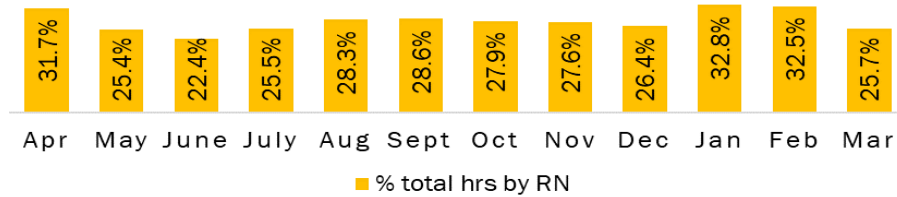

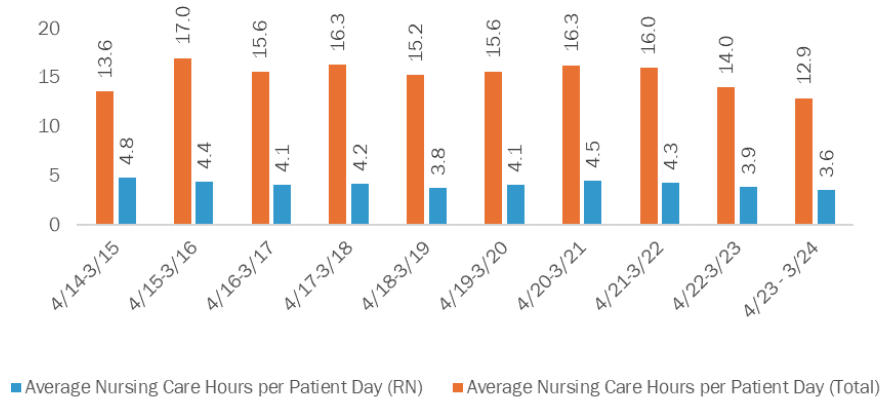

The graph below shows trend over time on the average RN and total nursing care hours per patient days.

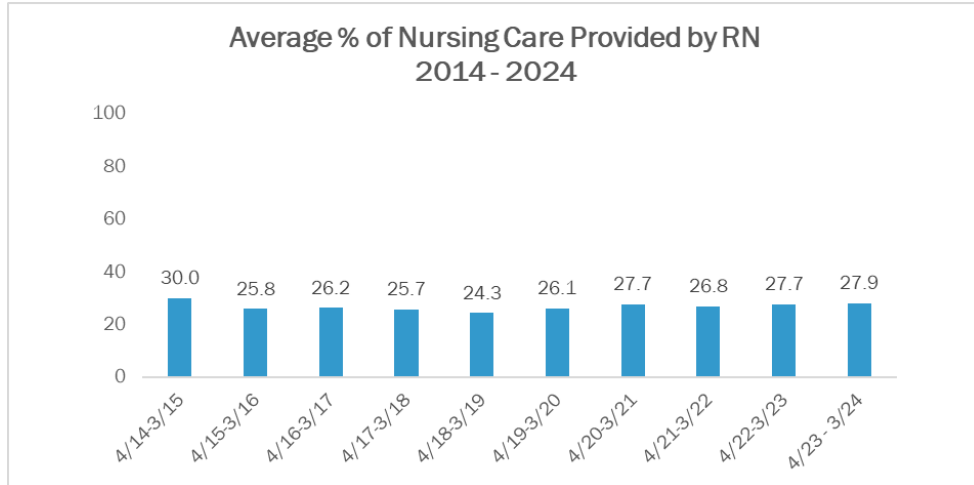
Adult Intensive Unit (Tyler 4) 2014-2024

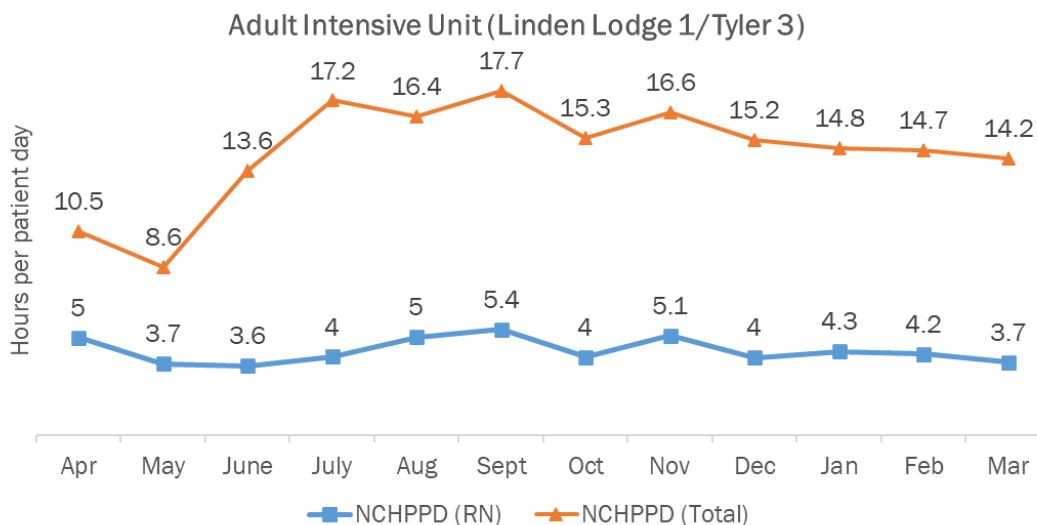

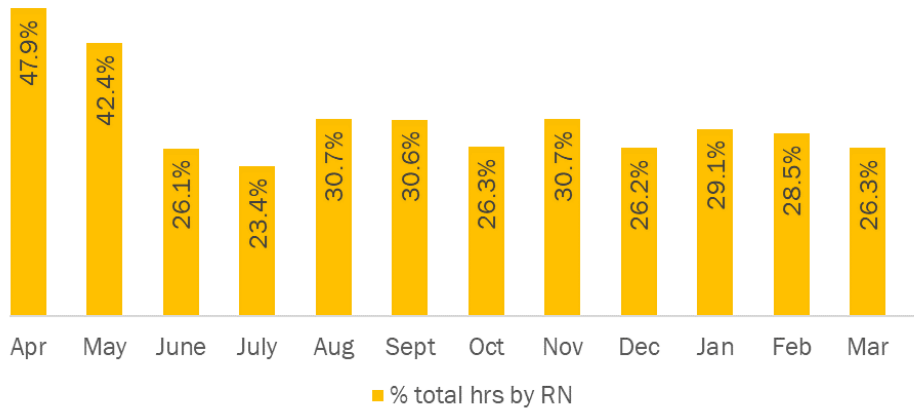

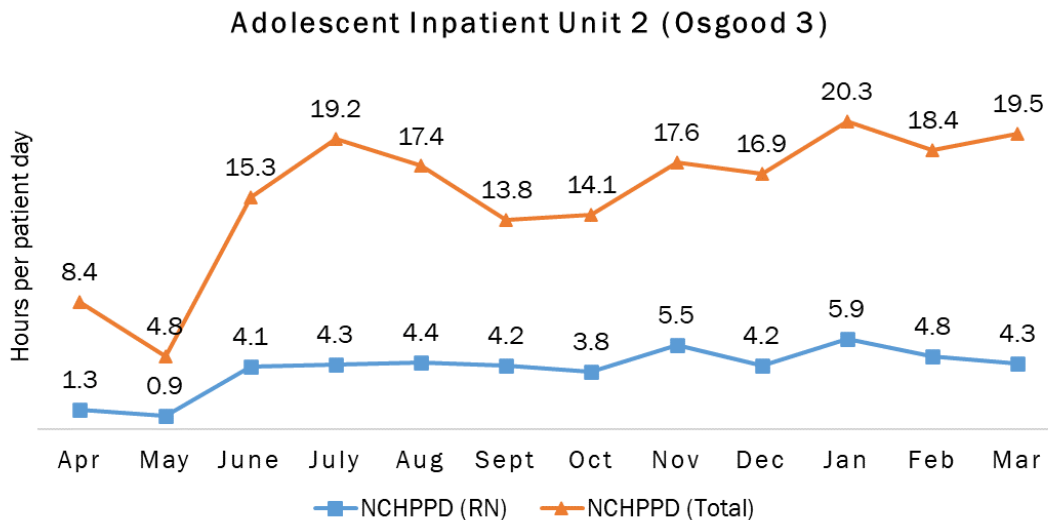

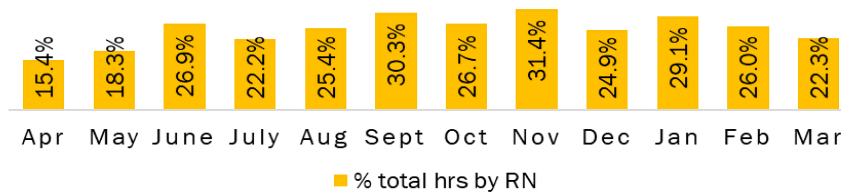

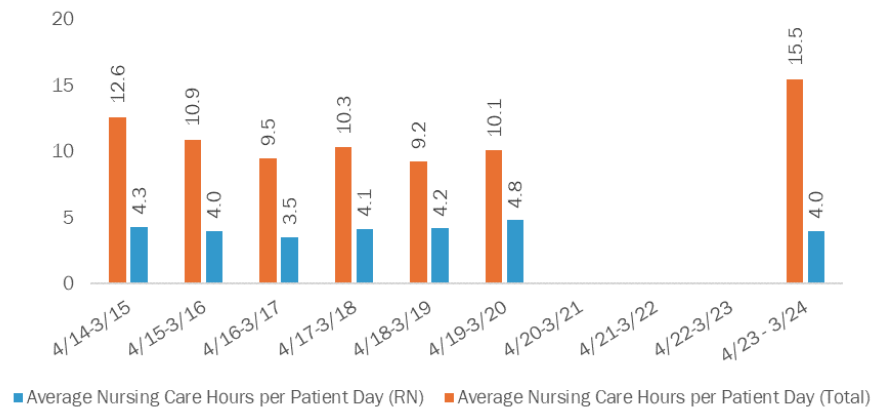

Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day

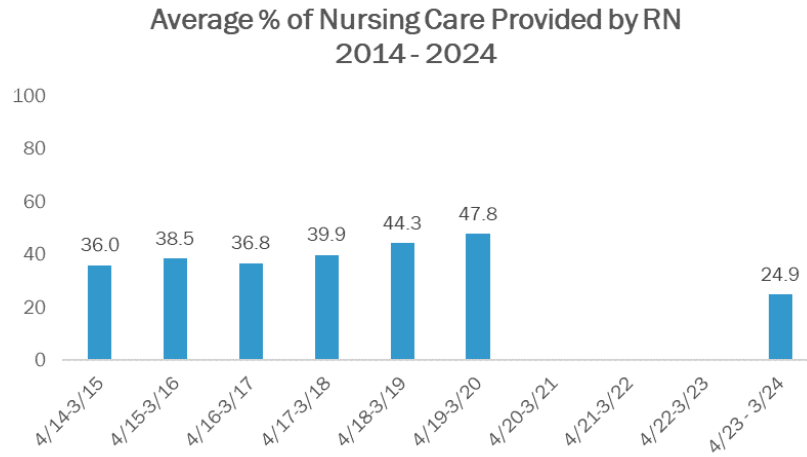

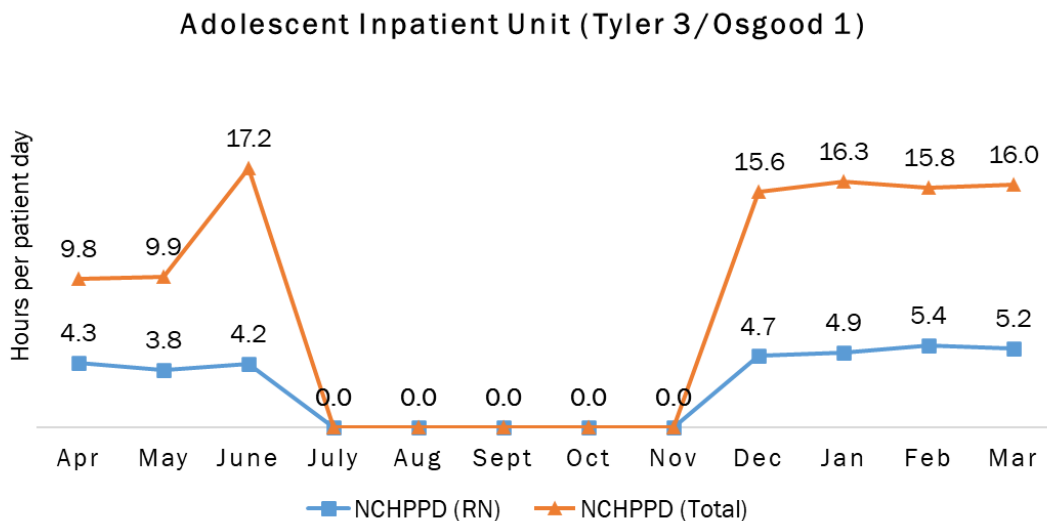

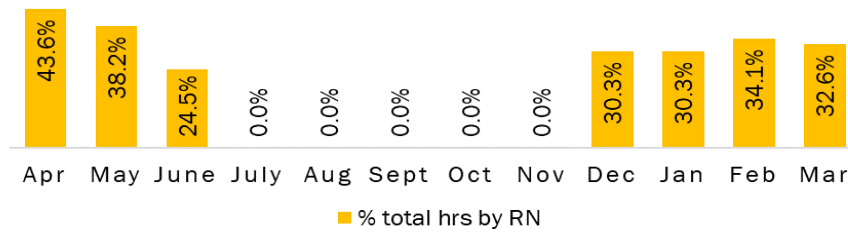

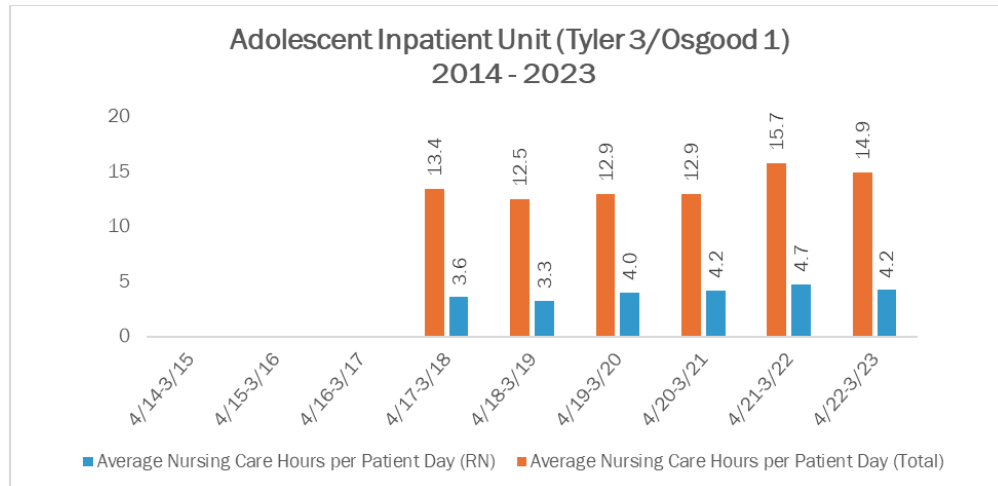

Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2014 - 2023

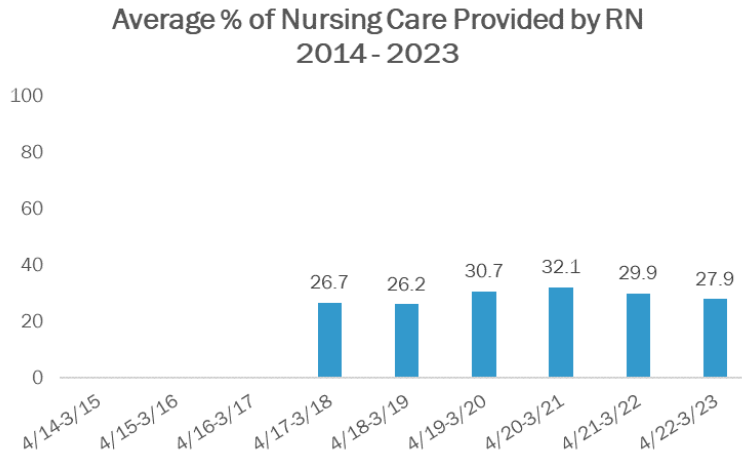

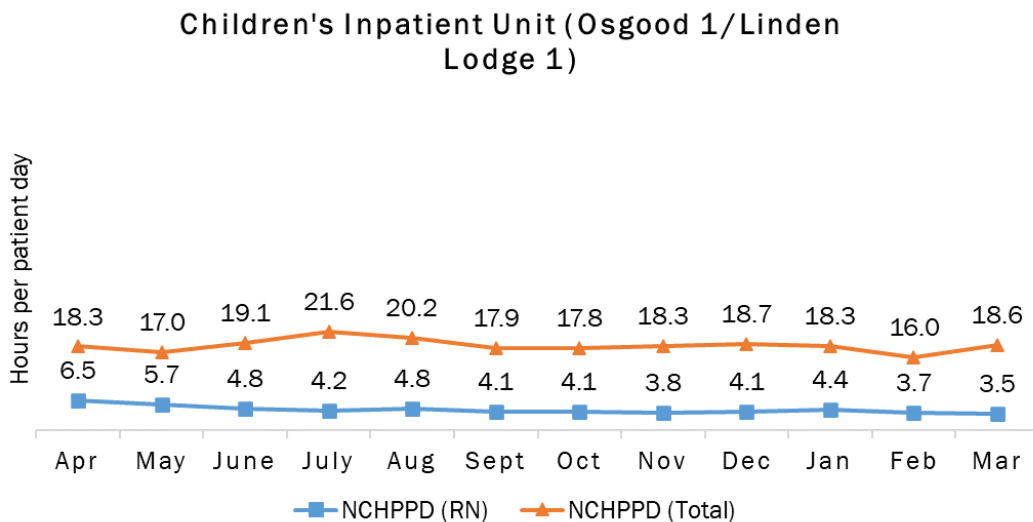

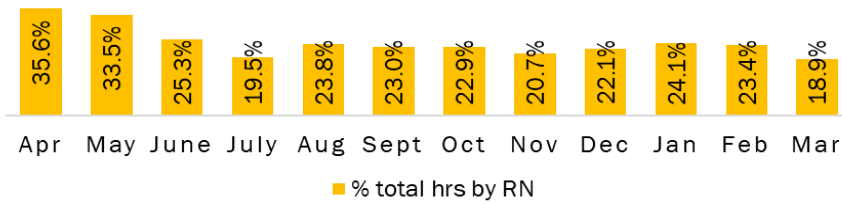

Percent of Total Nursing Care Hours Provided by RNs: April 2023 – March 2024

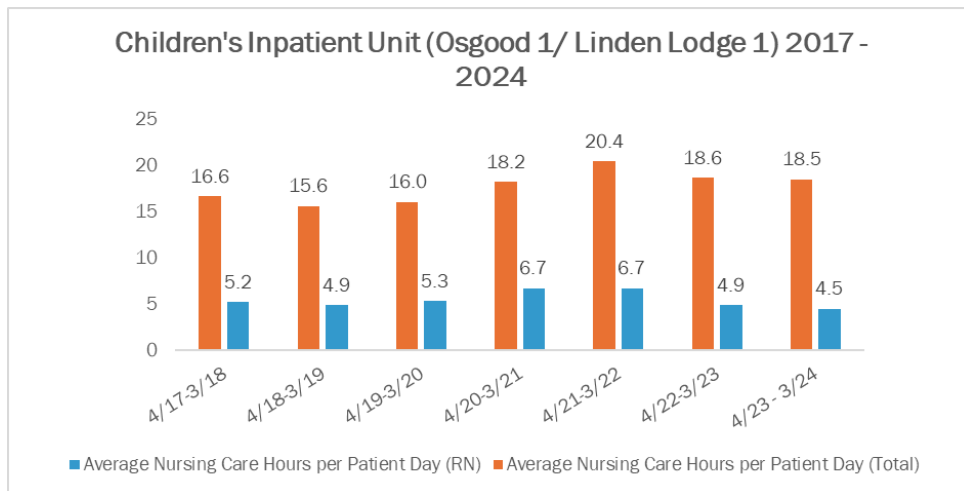
