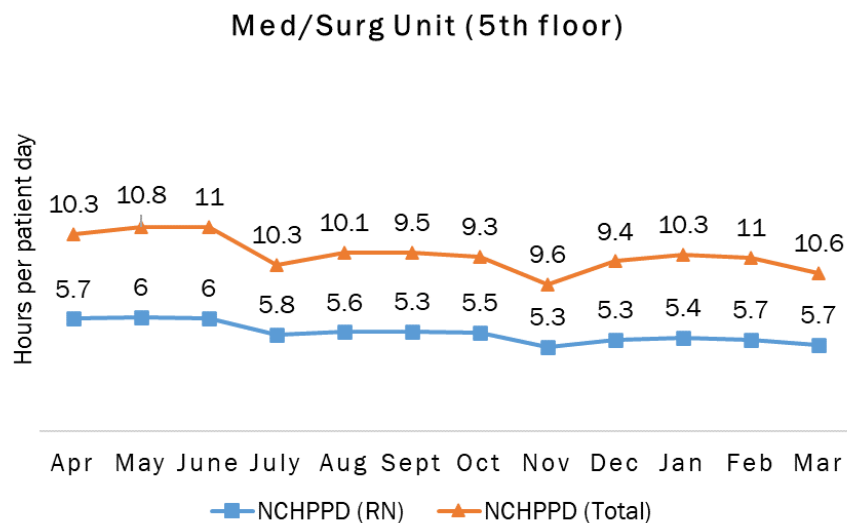

### Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day (NCHPPD): April 2023 - March 2024

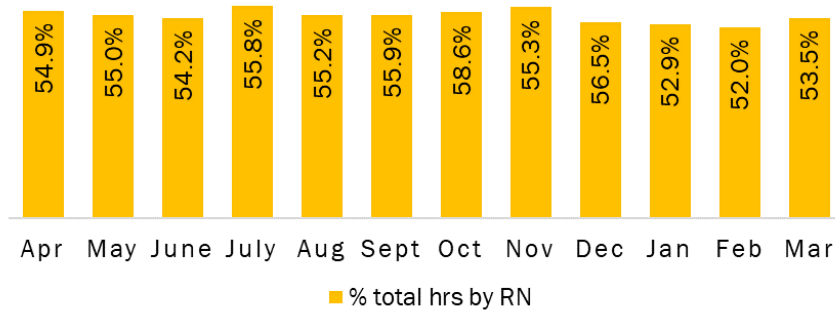

This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 54.99%.

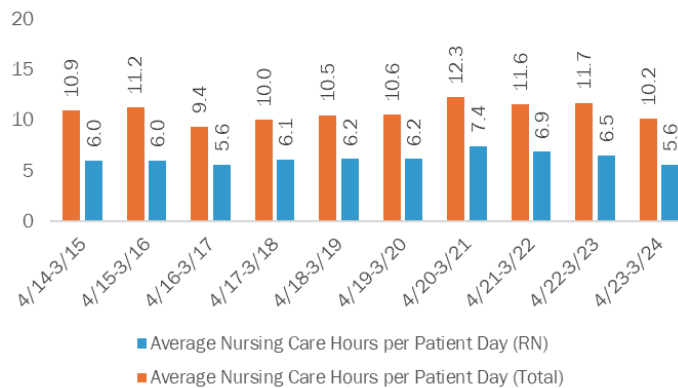

## Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2014 - 2024

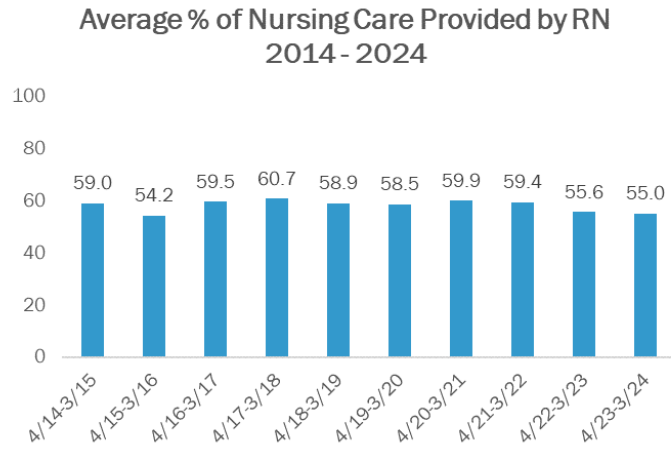
The graph below shows trend over time on the average RN and total nursing care hours per patient days.

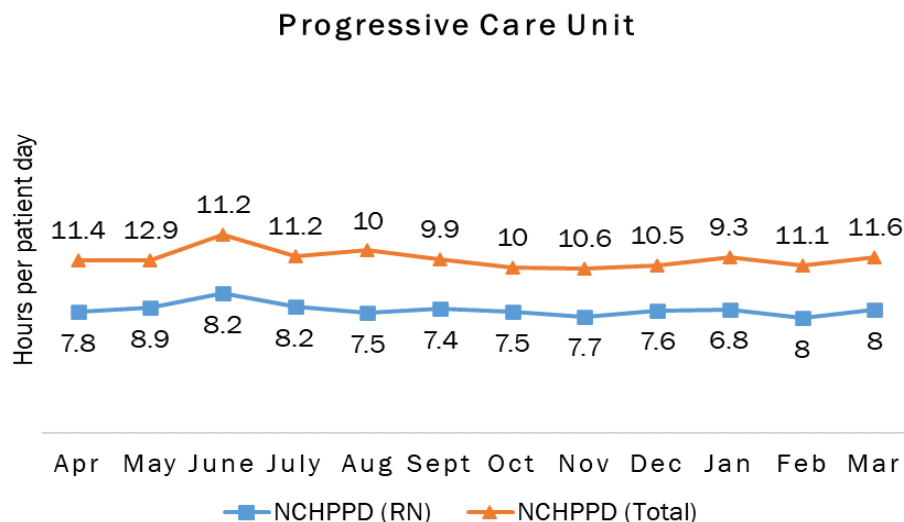

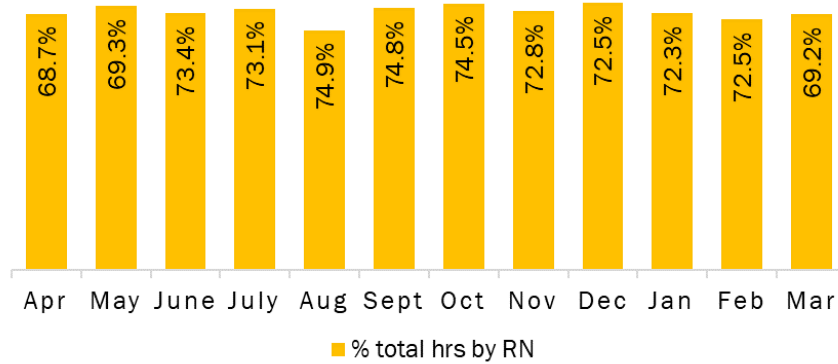

This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 72.33%.

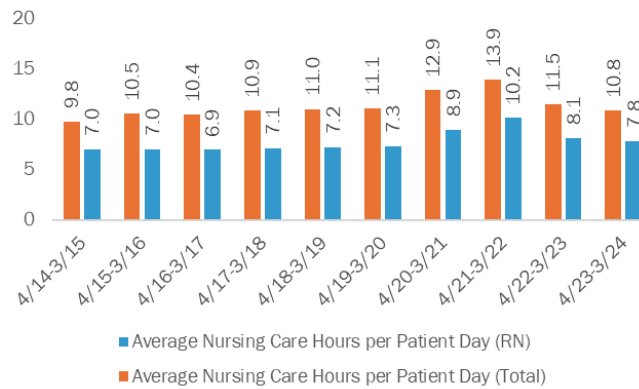

The graph below shows trend over time on the average RN and total nursing care hours per patient days.

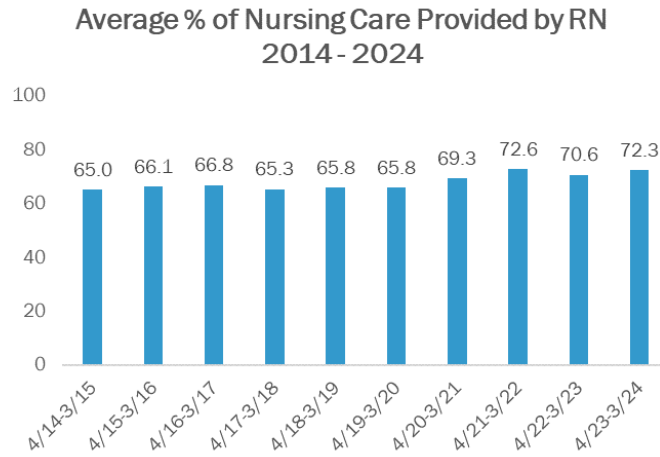
Progressive Care Unit 2014 - 2024

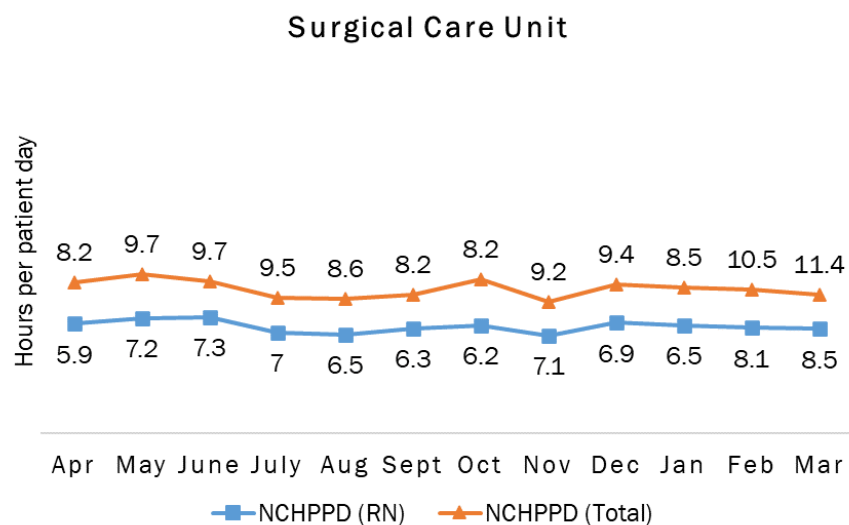

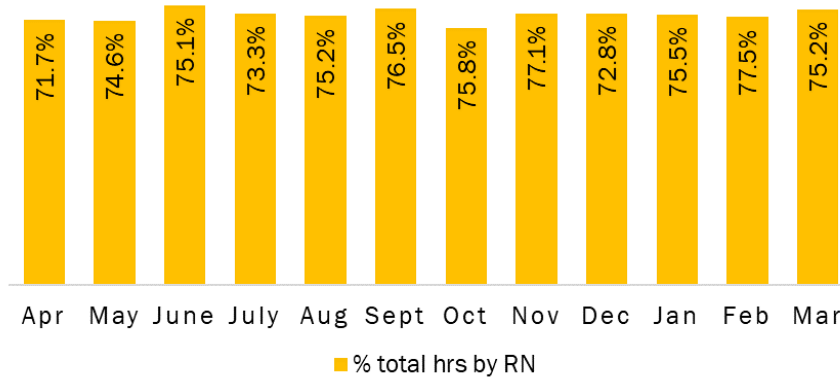

This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 75.03%.

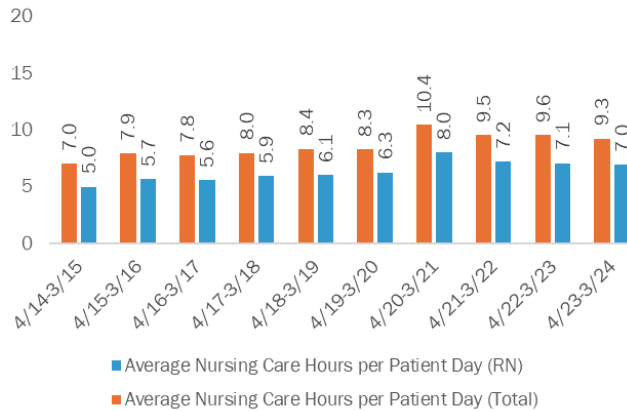

Surgical Care Unit 2014 - 2024

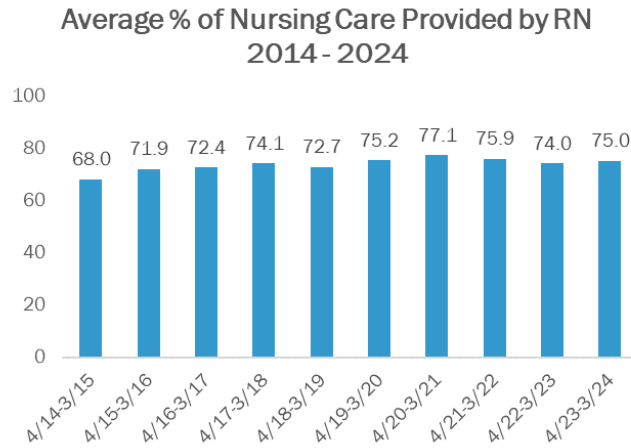

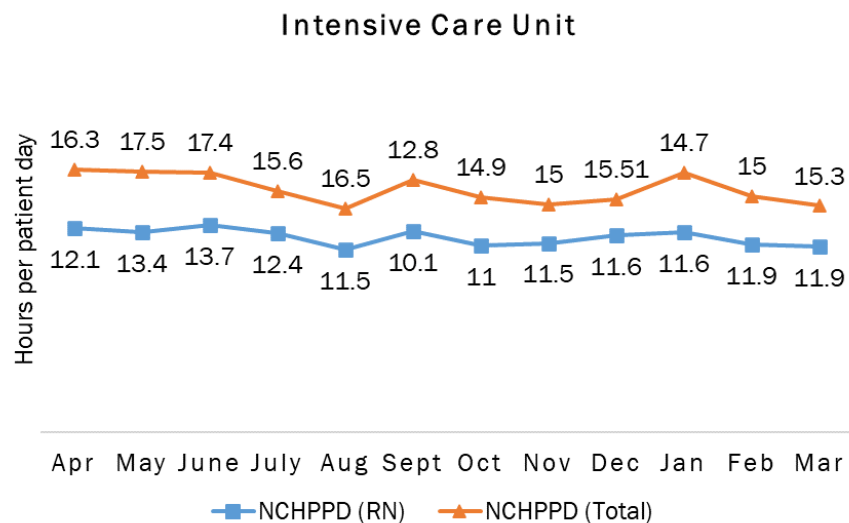

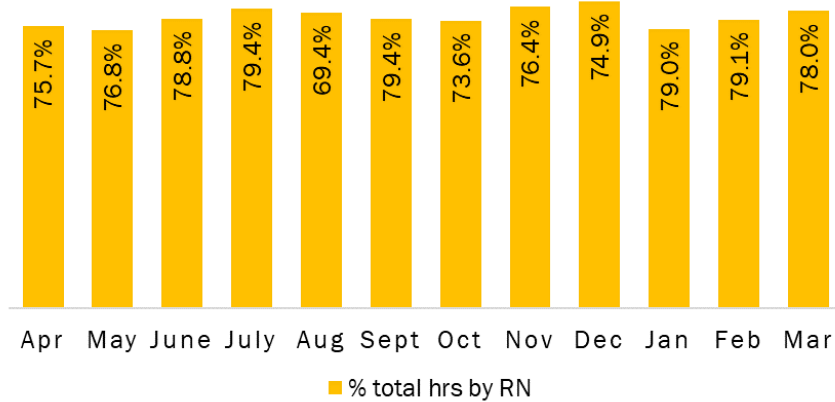

This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 76.71%.

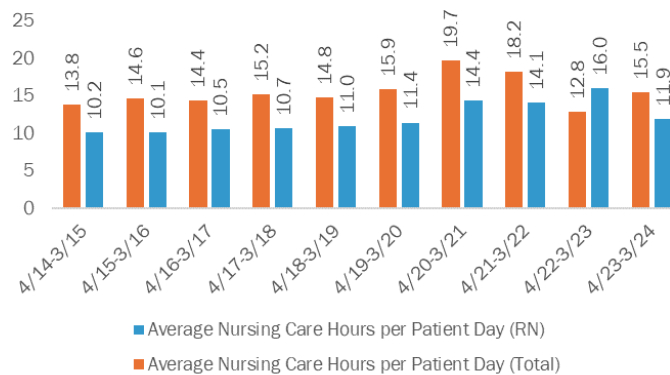

The graph below shows trend over time on the average RN and total nursing care hours per patient days.

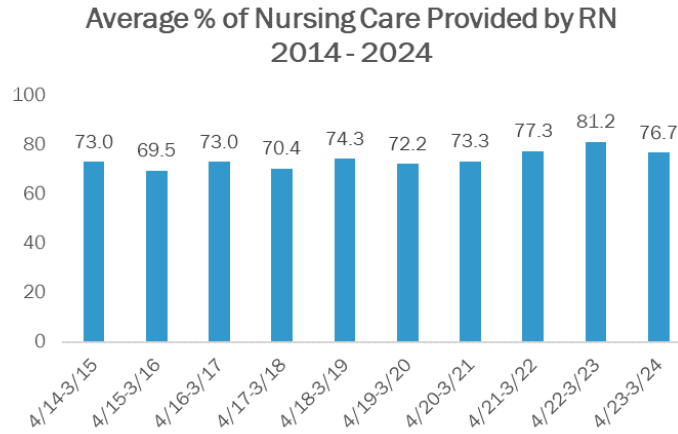
Intensive Care Unit 2014 - 2024

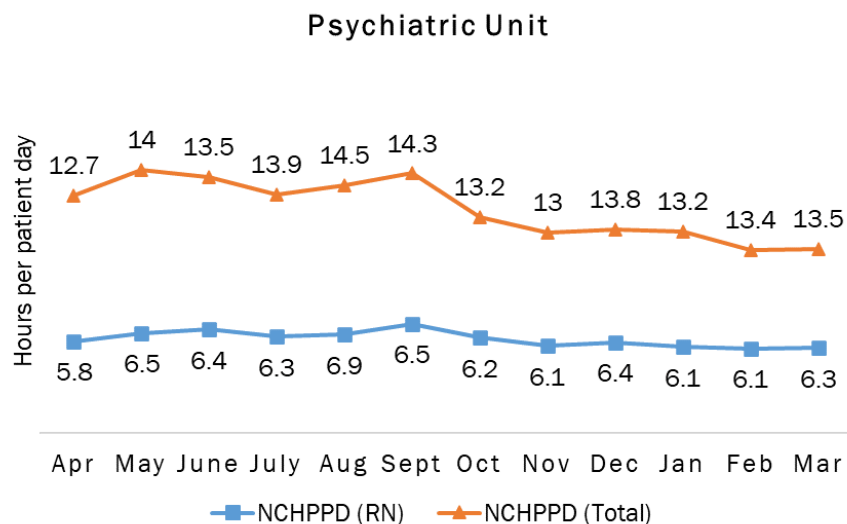

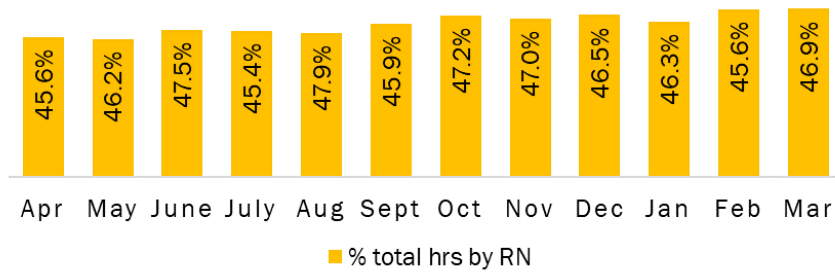

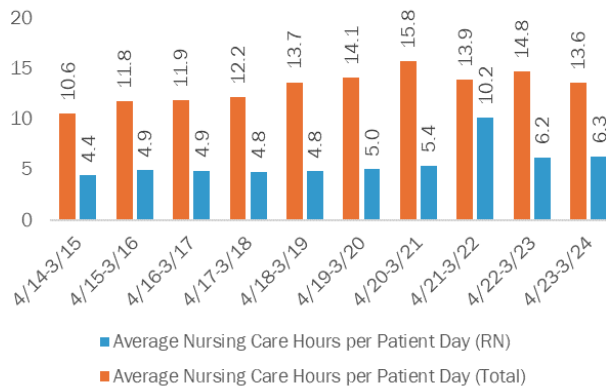

## Yearly Average of RN and Total Nursing Care Hours per Patient Day: 2014 - 2024

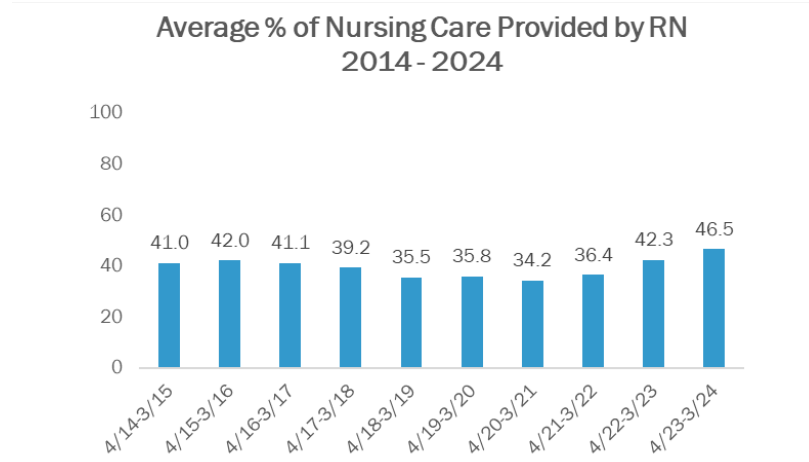

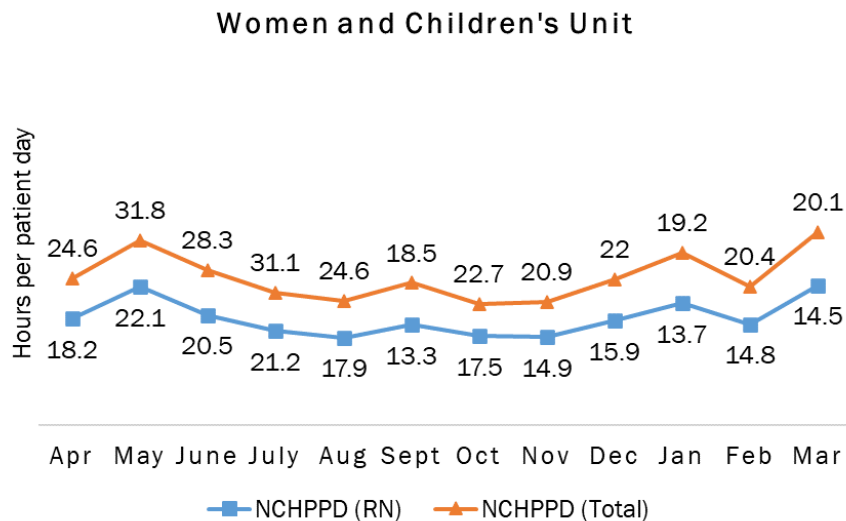

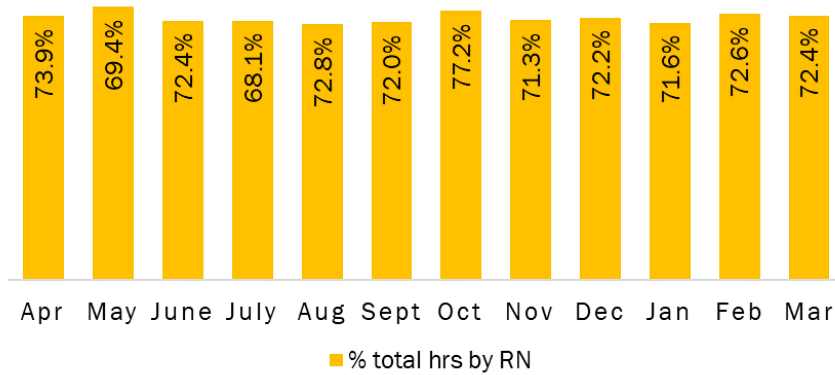




## Percent of Total Nursing Care Hours Provided by RNs: April 2023 – March 2024

This graph shows the percentage of total nursing hours provided by RNs each month. The yearly average for this period is 72.16%.

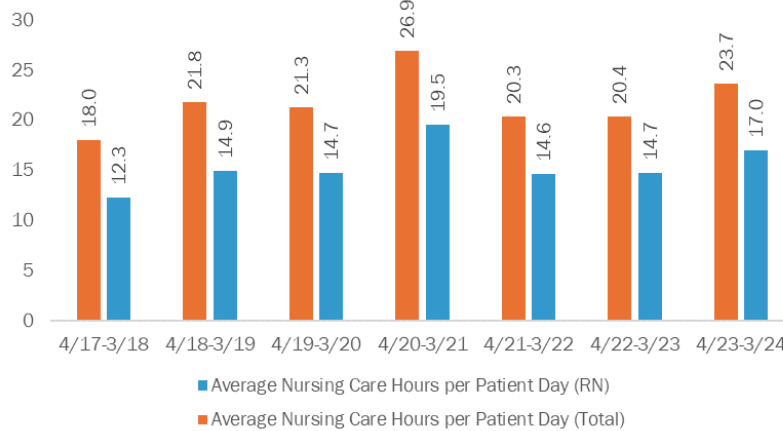
