These indicators represent data for the whole population of Vermont (unless otherwise specified). When the indicators are published in our public dashboards they will be disaggregated by geographic and demographic variables whenever possible.

As a department, we are committed to gathering, sharing, and utilizing data that reflects everyone. But it's important to understand that all data has its limits, and it can only give us a partial picture of the health of people in Vermont. We can't rely solely on data to tell the whole story.

We also realize that some of this data comes from institutions that have caused harm because of their policies and practices. This has led to some groups being left out or misrepresented in the data. Vermont is taking steps to make our data practices more equitable, to support federal agencies to improve how they collect and share data, and to provide context to help people understand our data better. In this way we hope to support a more accurate and beneficial interpretation of the information.
