
We developed <u>Overdose Prevention Center</u> (<u>OPC) Guidelines</u> to establish requirements for operating in Vermont.

Opioid overdose deaths are declining.


The number of deaths between Jan - Nov in 2024 (170) was **lower** than the average number of deaths for the same time period of the three prior years (211).

Average of 2021, 2022 & 2023






Youth substance use is declining.
