Mokambi ya IDRP to moto oyo baponi mpo na kotalela revours mpe mikanda nyonso oyo ezali na kati, akotalela likambo yango na moto oyo azali kotalela IDRP, akotala lisusu makambo mosusu nyonso ya ntina oyo azwi, mpe akosolola na mokambi ya DSU Clinical Services mpo na kozwa ekateli ya kolanda toli ya kosalisa moto.

Basangani bazali na mikolo 60 uta likambo ya ntina mpo na kosala recours. Bakondima mikanda ya recours na mokanda na mikolo 5-yango ekoki mpe kozala eyano na recours. IDRP ezali na mikolo 90 mpo na ksilisa recours.

Soki mosangani andimi te ekateli ya mokambi ya IDRP, akoki kosala recours na nkoma na mokambi ya division ya DSU na eleko ya mikolo 60 uta ekateli ya mokambi ya IDRP. Mokambi ya Division ya DSU azali na mikolo 90 mpo na kotalela recours.

Soki mosangani andimi te ekateli ya mokambi ya Division ya DSU, Division pénale ya Cour supérieure (engebene na 23 VSA § 1209(e)) ekozwa mokano.

## Appeal Process

### Appeal Process

An IDRP participant may appeal the decision of the IDRP Evaluator or IDRP Clinician, however participants cannot appeal any component of the IDRP that is included in the IDRP Administrative Rule (including the minimum number of sessions and weeks for treatment).

Participants may submit the appeal via mail (280 State Drive NOB 2 North Waterbury, VT 05671-8340), fax (1-866-272-7989), or email ([AHS.VDHIDRP@vermont.gov](mailto:AHS.VDHIDRP@vermont.gov)) or seek review of the decision in Superior Court pursuant to Rule 75 of the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure. The appeal must include:

- Participant name
- Participant date of birth
- DMV License number
- IDRP Education component location
- IDRP Evaluator name
- IDRP Clinician name
- Description of incident or reason for appeal
- Release of Confidential Information to speak with the participant's IDRP Clinician, IDRP Clinical Evaluator, and/or other person or organization that the participant determines would be applicable to the appeal.

The IDRP Director or designee will review the appeal and any accompanying materials or documents, discuss the request with the IDRP Evaluator, review any other pertinent information obtained, and consult the DSU Clinical Services Director to decide whether to uphold the treatment recommendation.

Participants have 60 days from the pertinent issue to file an appeal. Appeals will be acknowledged in writing within 5 calendar days—this may also be a response to the appeal. IDRP has 90 calendar days to address the appeal.

If the participant disagrees with the IDRP Director decision, they may appeal in writing to the DSU Division Director within 60 calendar days from the IDRP Director decision. The DSU Division Director has 90 calendar days to address the appeal.

If the participant disagrees with the DSU Division Director, the Criminal Division of the Superior Court (in accordance with 23 VSA § 1209(e)) will make a determination.
