

Per Diem Paramedic Position

Richmond Rescue is searching for per diem paramedics to supplement our volunteer and full-time staff. We serve seven towns in eastern Chittenden County and respond to 1,300 calls annually. We frequently pursue public health projects including bike helmet giveaways, car seat fittings, sharps disposal, and CPR training.

Responsibilities

- Be on duty, as needed, for 12-hour shifts. Most open shifts are on nights or weekends
- Perform a pre-shift ambulance check
- Offer training to your crew during their shift and while on calls
- Serve as the crew chief on calls

Qualifications:

- NREMT Paramedic with the ability to obtain Vermont licensure
- Be able to pass background checks
- Should have at least one year of crew chief experience
- Ambulance driving experience is useful but not required

Benefits:

- Pay rates start at \$28.81/hr for paramedics. Higher for those with more experience.
- Possibility of qualifying for our SIMPLE IRA after two years of employment
- Free skiing at Bolton Valley
- If qualified, the ability to join our backcountry rescue team
