

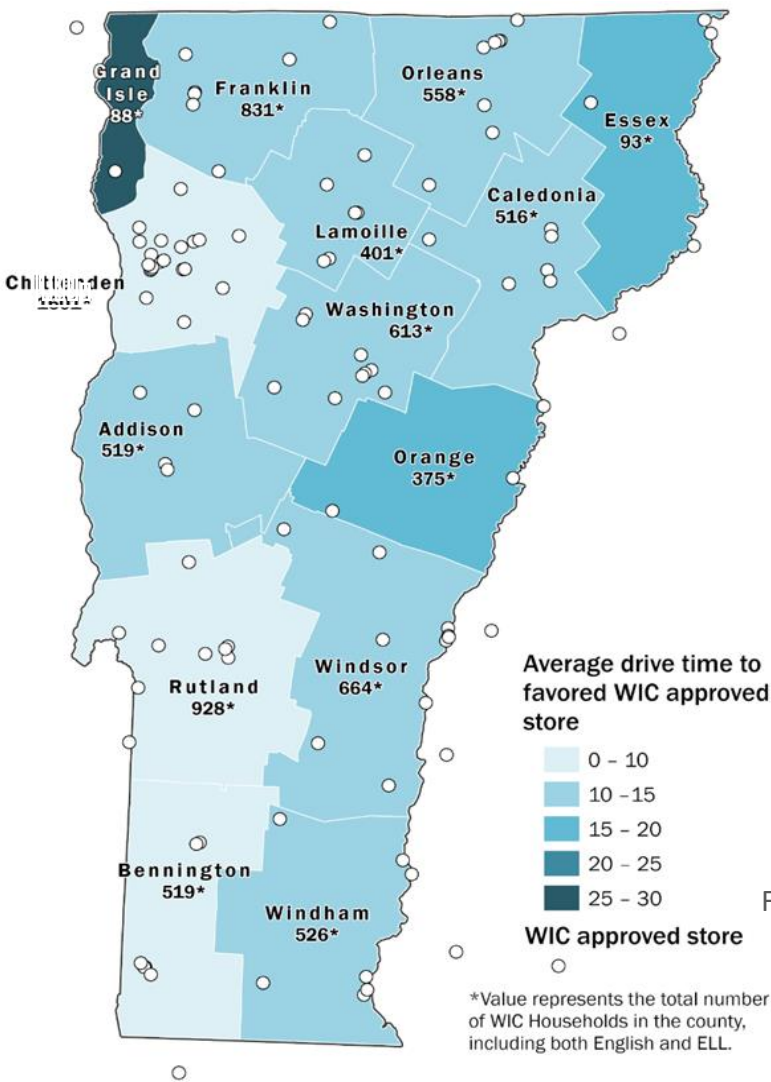
## English Language Learning (ELL) households are more likely to have a drivetime of less than 10 minutes to their preferred grocery store.

Eighty-five percent of WIC ELL households are in Chittenden County, which has the highest concentration of grocery stores. This means ELL families in that area have a shorter drive time to a grocery store. Alternatively, WIC participants living in a rural area (regardless of preferred language) have a longer drive time to a grocery store due to fewer store options.
