What 2 items should be at every register:

1. WIC Decal and Training Card
2. Vermont WIC Food Guide and Training Log
3. **Vermont WIC Food Guide and Cashier Tip Card**

WIC Decal goes on front door and Training Log is kept at customer service.

VT WIC Food Guide and Cashier Tip Cards should be kept at all registers as a reference.

Which produce items need to be mapped? Check all that apply.

1. **Bolthouse Farms Bagged Carrots**
2. **Store cut up watermelon sections**
3. **Bagged salad mix**

All of the Above, all are fresh produce items with UPC codes that have to be linked to a PLU.

If you are having issues with a WIC transaction, what do you do? Check all that apply.

1. Ask for help with "WIC" on the intercom
2. **Ask the FE supervisor/lead for assistance**
3. **Check your Vermont WIC Food Guide or Cashier Tip Card**
4. **Suspend the transaction and move to customer service**
5. **Be patient, wait 20 seconds and try again**

Depending on your store, all except for identifying WIC on the intercom. That would be breaking confidentiality rules.

On October 1st, 2024, what food category is changing allowable sizes?

1. Whole Wheat Pasta
2. Jarred Baby Foods
3. **Whole Wheat/ Whole Grain Bread**
4. Breakfast Cereal

Authorized whole wheat and whole grain breads will be expanded to allow sizes other than just 16 oz. loaves.
