Be Ready!

To receive immunization histories from the IMR, you must be able to receive and display *all* CVX codes. For an updated list, visit:

Be Aware!

The IMR is linked with Vital Records; if a patient is born in Vermont, we will have the name on the birth certificate. *We do update names after adoptions (monthly) and marriages (annually).*

Be Prepared!

Vaccine events are recorded by our first-in policy: and cannot be updated or changed from an HL7 sender once entered into the IMR.

For example, if a Hep B NOS (unspecified) is entered by a pharmacy, their primary care provider will be unable to add updated information to the record through HL7.
